**Scholarship:** 2.7+ GPA (B or greater cumulative grade point average)

**Eligibility:** NAHS are grades 9-12 & NJAHS are grades 7-8.

**Candidate Information & Registration Forms:** Due March 14, 2024.

**Officer Candidate Form:** Due April 2, 2024.

**Points:** 125 points must be posted by February 1st to be considered.

**Evaluation:** Candidate evaluations will be completed & announced by March 1st.

**Rehearsal:** May 20th @ 2:30pm in the HHS Gymnasium.

**Induction Ceremony:** Night of the Arts @ 7pm. HHS publicly recognizes members at our community-wide ceremony. Inducted and honored members will receive a pin, society flower boutonniere, and certificate.

**Attire:** Black or White Formal

**Seniors:** Seniors will earn a honor cord & pin to be worn at graduation. As well as a society flower boutonniere and certificate.

Our chapter has worked hard to bring the accomplishments of outstanding students to the attention of parents, teachers, peers, and the community.
